### **Françoise Viénot will receive the Judd award 2015.**

Françoise Viénot is currently Emeritus professor, Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle, Paris. She is an expert in color vision and appearance measurement, research on colorimetry, photometry, gloss metrics and LED illumination. She has been French representative and former officer of CIE Division 1 (Vision), chair of CIE TC 1-36 "Chromaticity diagram with physiologically significant axes", vice-president of CIE-France. She received Newton medal (Colour Group of Great Britain) and Verriest medal (International Colour Vision Society).
